learned A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Barhara P.S. Case No. 139 of 2024, dated 19.03.2024
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323,
379, 411, 353, 504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Learned A.P.P. for the State, at the outset, submits
that the offences for which the instant FIR has been instituted
carry punishment of less than seven years.

4. The said submission of the learned A.P.P. for the
State is not disputed by the learned counsel appearing on behalf
of the petitioner.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
investigation of the case against the petitioner is still going on
and the petitioner has not been given the benefit of Section

Misc. No. 3536 of 2024.
