2 06-08-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

*“1. That, this is an application for
issuance of the appropriate writ
/writs, order / orders or direction
/directions to the respondent
authorities to remove the
encroachment from the Public Land /
Anabad Survasadharen situated
under Mauja-Budharika, Thana*



*No.346, Khata No.70, Plot No.119,
Area 41 decimals, Plot No.191 total
Area 1.07 Acres has been
encroached by the respondents no.
5 to 8 and others."*

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks a direction upon the Circle Officer, Sheosagar, District-Rohtas, to dispose off the pending Encroachment Case No. 02 of 2024.

3. *Per contra*, the learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that in case the aforesaid Encroachment Case is still pending, the same would definitely be disposed off within a stipulated time frame, as is fixed by this Court.

4. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it fit and proper to direct the Circle Officer, Sheosagar, District-Rohtas to dispose off the aforesaid Encroachment Case No. 02 of 2024, in case the same is still pending, by passing the final order under Section 6(1) of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956, in accordance with law and after hearing the affected parties, within a period of six weeks of



receipt/production of a copy of this order.

5. The writ petition stands disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
