ORAL ORDER

A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with B.P. Spl. Act No. 2156 of 2024 (arising out of Bodh Gaya) P.S. Case No. 288/2024 dated 12.06.2024 registered for the offences punishable u/s 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 45.750 litres of illicit English liquor was recovered from the bag tied on the seat of the motorcycle which was parked at the door of the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious



possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. The petitioner is not the owner of the said motorcycle. The petitioner has clean antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 13.06.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Gaya in connection with B.P. Spl. Act No. 2156 of 2024 (arising out of Bodh Gaya) P.S. Case No. 288/2024.

7. The application stands allowed.
