2 19-02-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

*“1.A) To issue a writ in nature of
Certiorari setting aside the order
dated 01.03.2023 passed in
Anganbari Appeal Case No. 34/2021
passed by District Collector, Supaul
whereby and whereunder he found
claim of Respondent No.9, not in*



accordance with guidelines of selecting and approved the order of dismissal by District Programme Officer I.C.D.S., Supaul, but he did not stop there and went ahead setting aside selection of petitioner thus, partially setting aside order dated 24.03.2020 passed in Anganbari Case No. 15/2018.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, including that of filing a suit before the Ld. Civil Court having competent jurisdiction, for redressal of the aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
