2 06-08-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1. That this is an application for issuance of appropriate writ/writs including Quo Warranto declaring the appointment and continuance of respondent no. 7 as illegal, without proper qualification as Siksha Mitra and Panchayat Teacher and ordinary for taking action of removal from services, recovery of all payment



received and lodging F.I.R. as directed by the Hon'ble Court in CWJC No.15459 of 2014 dated 22.6.2015 for obtaining appointment on forged Intermediate Certificate."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, he seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the Principal Secretary, Education Department, Government of Bihar, Patna for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
