ORAL ORDER

2 24-07-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioners have preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Raghunathpur Excise P.S. Case No. 62/2024 dated 10.05.2024 registered for the offence punishable u/s 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 238. 320 litres of illicit foreign and country-made liquor were recovered from the petitioners.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are innocent and have falsely been



implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioners. The petitioners are not the owner of the said motorcycles. The petitioner no. 1 is accused in three criminal case whereas the petitioner no. 2 has clean antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioners are in custody since 11.05.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioners.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioners above-named, are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Siwan, in connection with Raghunathpur Excise P.S. Case No. 62/2024.

7. The application stands allowed.
