ORAL ORDER

2 30-07-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Excise (Sherghati) P.S. Case No. 98 of 2024 dated 24.06.2024 registered for the offences punishable u/s 30(a) and 32(c) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 1880 litres of illicit country made liquor was recovered *from the Summo Car*.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner is the owner of the said vehicle. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. Nothing has



been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner.
The petitioner has clean antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 24.06.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the nature of allegation levelled against the petitioner and the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Gaya, in connection with Excise (Sherghati) P.S. Case No. 98 of 2024.

7. The application stands allowed.
