2 20-07-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Bhairav
Asthan P.S. Case No. 89 of 2023 instituted for the offences
under Section 394 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Prosecution case, in short, is that when the
informant along with his cousin was on his way, he was
accosted by four unknown miscreants, who on the point of
pistol snatched their mobile phones and motorcycle.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the
petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case.
Petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. The name of the petitioner
transpired in this case on the basis of his self-confession made



in Bhairavsthan P.S. Case No. 95 of 2023. No incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Learned counsel further submitted that petitioner has got no concern with the looted articles. The co-accused person has already been granted bail by this Bench vide order dated 12.03.2024 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 15578 of 2024. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 25.07.2023 and has two criminal antecedents.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, claim based on parity as also the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Bhairav Asthan P.S. Case No. 89 of 2023.
