ORAL ORDER

2 13-08-2024 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well
as the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioner is seeking regular bail in connection
with Murar P.S. Case No. 41 of 2024 for the offences punishable
under Sections 20(B) (ii) a/27(a) of the NDPS Act.

3. As per allegation, on a secret information, the
informant along with police personnel reached the place of
occurrence. After seeing the police party, the accused persons
including the petitioner tried to flee away but they were
apprehended. On search, 677 gms of *Ganja* was recovered from
bag of the petitioner. A mobile set and Rs. 5020/- were also
alleged to be recovered from the pocket of petitioner.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted
that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in



this case. The alleged recovered contraband comes under small quantity. He has further submitted that the petitioner is a person of clean antecedent and is under custody 09.06.2024.

6. Considering the above-mentioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above-named be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand rupees) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned District and Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge NDPS Act, Buxar in connection with Murar P.S. Case No. 41 of 2024, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court.
