ORAL ORDER

2 14-08-2024 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well
as the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioner is seeking regular bail in connection
with Salimpur P.S. Case No. 198 of 2024 for the offences
punishable under Sections 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and
Excise (Amendment) Act, 2022.

3. As per allegation, the informant along with police
personnel was on patrolling duty. The accused person including
the petitioner tried to flee away after seeing the police party, but
he was apprehended. On search, 39.2 liters of liquor was
recovered from a motorcycle.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted
that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in
this case. He has further submitted that nothing was recovered



from possession of the petitioner. He has also submitted that the petitioner is a person of clean antecedent and is under custody since 01.07.2024.

5. On the other hand, the learned APP for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Considering the above-mentioned facts and circumstances as well as the clean antecedent, let the petitioner above-named be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand rupees) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge Excise, Barh in connection with Salimpur P.S. Case No. 198 of 2024, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court.
