2 12-02-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1. That present application is directed against order dated 13/05/23 passed in Anganwadi appeal case no. 122/2019 whereby and whereunder learned District Magistrate cum Collector, Kishanganj has erroneously rejected the appeal without considering the material fact available on the record and upheld the order dated. 18-09-19 passed by District Programme Officer, ICDS, Kishanganj in Anganwadi case no. 43/2018-19 Whereby and whereunder



District Programme Officer, ICDS, Kishanganj has rejected the petition filed by petitioner against Private respondent No.6, namely, Sulekha Devi who have been selected on the post of Anganwadi Sevika by producing the documents which was obtained by making fraud.”

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law including that of filing a suit before the learned Civil Court having competent jurisdiction. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
3. The writ petition stands disposed off as not pressed.
