2 02-07-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that this writ petition may be disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to file a detailed representation before respondent no. 6 i.e. District Magistrate, Munger annexing all the relevant documents in support of their claim within a period of six weeks.



3. In view of the aforesaid, the respondent no. 6 is directed to consider the representation of the petitioners on its own merit and decide the same within a period of three months. If the decision of the respondent no. 6 is found to be in favour of the petitioner then the same shall be communicated to the petitioners and all the consequential benefits shall also be given to the petitioners within a period of two months, thereafter.

4. Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed of with the aforesaid liberty.
