ORAL ORDER

2 31-08-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Akbarpur P.S. Case No. 546 of 2023 dated 03.12.2023 registered for the offences punishable u/ss 30(a), 30(d) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 217 litres of illicit country made liquor and 3999 litres of fermented Jawa Mahua were recovered from the forest area near *Kolwa Pahadi*.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged



recovery. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Similarly situated co-accused person has already been granted anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 27.06.2024 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 25981 of 2024. The petitioner has one criminal antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 23.06.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Nawada in connection with Akbarpur P.S. Case No. 546 of 2023.

7. The application stands allowed.
