2 21-02-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following reliefs:-

“1. That, this writ application is being filed for issuance of appropriate writ/ writs, order/ orders, direction/ directions to the respondents authority in nature of Certiorari for setting aside the order dated 25.03.2021 passed by learned Deputy Development Commissioner, Patna in Memo No. 04-22- /2020-507 dated 25.03.2021 whereas the petitioner has been dismissed from the post of Assistant



(Rural Housing Development Department) in the light at Memo. 266 dated 13.02.2021."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already challenged the impugned order of punishment dated 24.03.2021, passed by the Deputy Development Commissioner, Patna, by filing an appeal before the Principal Secretary, Rural Development Department, Government of Bihar, Patna, in the year 2021, hence the same be directed to be disposed off.

3. Having regard to the limited prayer made by the petitioner in the present writ petition, I deem it fit and proper to direct the Principal Secretary, Rural Development Department, Government of Bihar, Patna to dispose off the aforesaid appeal filed by the petitioner, in case the same has actually been filed and is still pending, by passing a reasoned and a speaking order, in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks of receipt/production of a copy of this order.

4. The writ petition stands disposed off on



the aforesaid terms.
