2 19-08-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following reliefs:-

*“1(i) That for a direction to the
respondents to pay the amount of*



Succession Certificate Rs.17,15,803/- to the petitioner, who is the Nati of Late Raj Kishori Devi and Late Dr. Ayodhya Prasad Singh 'Prakash' and son of Late Ambuj Prakash and Sri Ram Lakhan Prasad Singh and Late Ambuj Prakash was the only son of Late Raj Kishori Devi and Late Dr. Ayodhya Prasad Singh 'Prakash'.

(ii) That for payment of interest @ 18% per annum on amount of Succession Certificate of Rs.17,15,803/- for the period from 09-08-2016 to 30-06-2024 is Rs. 24,36,783/- (Twenty Four Lacs Thirty Six Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty Three) and up to the date of final payment to the petitioner as per order / direction of Supreme Court of India in Civil Appeal No.687/2000 (Vijay L. Mehrotra vs. State of Utter Pradesh and Others vide order dated 31-01-2000 and Hon'ble Patna High Court in C.W.J.C. No. 6852/2021 (Lilawati Mishra Versus State of Bihar) vide order dated 11-05-2022.

(iii) That for payment of exemplary cost quantified at Rs. 5,00,000/- (Five lacs) for harassing the legal heirs and petitioner.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner



to avail the liberty already granted by the learned Division Bench of this Court vide order dated 23.02.2022, passed in a writ petition filed by the petitioner earlier, i.e. CWJC No. 12229 of 2021. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The present writ petition stands disposed off.
