2 06-03-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

*“1. That this is an application for
issuance of a writ in the nature of
Mandamus for commanding and
directing the respondent authorities to
grant seniority in the light of the order
dated 13.01.2014, passed in CWJC No.
10206 of 2008 as the several juniors to
the petitioner have been given
promotion/seniority ignoring the case
of the petitioner and/or for issuance of
such other order or direction for which
the petitioner may be found legally*



entitled to in the facts and circumstances of the matter as stated hereinafter."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks a direction upon the Superintendent of Police, Nawada to consider the case of the petitioner for grant of the due promotion/seniority. It is directed accordingly.

3. It is needless to state that in case the petitioner approaches the Superintendent of Police, Nawada i.e. the respondent no. 5, by filing appropriate representation, within a period of two weeks from today, the same shall be disposed off by a reasoned and a speaking order, in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks, thereafter.

4. The writ petition stands disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
