seeking the following relief:-

"1. That the present application is being filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus commanding the respondents to fix the petitioner's family pension giving benefits of 6th & 7th pay revision commissions upto date with interest as well as the A.C.P. to the petitioner's husband posthumously and all other equitable reliefs she is found entitled to."
