2 02-01-2024 1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief(s):-

“1. That this writ application is being filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of "Mandamus" Commanding and directing the Respondents authorities to give benefits of due amount of A.C.P. and M.A.C.P. Scheme for his long service period as for the same he is entitled to;”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the



respondent no.02 i.e. the Principal Secretary, Water Resources, Department of Irrigation, Government of Bihar, Patna for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty so sought is granted.
