2 26-07-2024 The learned counsel for the opposite parties submits that in view of the interim order dated 18.2.2019, passed by this Court, in CWJC No. 2913 of 2019, directing the Respondents not to make any recovery from the petitioner, no order of recovery has been issued by the opposite parties, as has been stated categorically paragraph no. 9 of the show cause, filed in the present case.
