3 25-09-2024 Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

2. The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Jadiya P.S. Case No. 270/2023, registered for the offence under
Sections 302, 201, 120B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, the dead body of the
deceased was found subsequently during investigation, the co-
accused Shambhu Sah has made confessional statement saying
that he along with the petitioner had brutally killed the deceased.
They cut the penis of the deceased also and side mirror of the
petitioner was recovered from the place of occurrence and the
motorcycle of the petitioner was recovered from the house of the
petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence. The



petitioner has two criminal antecedent and in both cases he is on bail. The name of the petitioner surfaced in this case on the confessional statement of apprehended co-accused. The petitioner is in custody since 18.01.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer for bail and submits that the petitioner was also involved in the said crime.

6. Considering the role of the petitioner in the crime, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Accordingly, this application for regular bail is dismissed.
