2 28-02-2024 The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during the Covid-19 pandemic period, the petitioner had filed writ petitions, however, inadvertently, two writ petitions were filed i.e. the present one and one another writ petition bearing CWJC No. 18543 of 2021, seeking same and similar reliefs, hence, the



present writ petition be disposed off as not pressed, however with liberty to the petitioner to pursue the other writ petition.

2. Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed off as not pressed, however, it is clarified that the withdrawal of the present writ petition shall not prejudice the right of the petitioner to prosecute the other writ petition, filed by him, i.e. the one bearing CWJC No. 18543 of 2021.
