seeking the following relief:-

*"1. I) For issuance of an appropriate
direction, order, or writ in the nature of
mandamus commanding the
respondents to dispose of the
representation dated 14-06-2023 as
contained in Annexure- P 4 of this writ
application and further by directing the
Respondents no. 5 to 8 to remove the*



illegal construction which they have done after encroaching the public road and land of petitioner bearing Khata no.- 65, Khesra no. 1178 / 2452, Jamabandi no.- 195, Thana no. 73 measuring 0-9- 16-0 (9 Katta 16 Dhur) situated at Village-Rautouli, Ward no.- 9, P.S.-Pipra, District- Supaul."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, for redressal of the aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
3. The writ petition stands dismissed.
