ORAL ORDER

2 14-08-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. This is an application for regular bail on behalf of the petitioner for the offences alleged under Sections 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, registered in connection with Excise P.S. Case No. 1061 of 2024.

3. As per prosecution case, there has been recovery of 8.64 liters of liquor from the motorcycle of the petitioner. It is further alleged that from other motorcycles, illicit liquor has also been recovered.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and has committed no offence. Petitioner has no concern either with the



alleged recovery of liquor or with the seized vehicles. On the basis of suspicion, he has been made accused in this case. No incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Petitioner is a person of clean antecedent and he is in custody since 01.07.2024.

5. Learned APP for the State has opposed the prayer of bail.

6. Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case as well as petitioner is a person of clean antecedent, let the petitioner, above-named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court of Exclusive Special Excise Court No. 2, Motihari, East Champaran in connection with Excise P.S. Case No. 1061 of 2024, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall co-operate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the Court.
