seeking the following reliefs:-

*“1. That this writ application is being
filed for issuance of appropriate writ /
order / direction for the issuance of a
writ in the nature of writ of Mandamus
or any other appropriate writ / Order /
direction for quashing the order dated*



09.02.2021 passed by in the court of Collector-cum-District Magistrate, East Champaran at Motihari in Anganwadi Case No. 12/2017 (PoonamKumari vs. State and Others) whereby and whereunder the petitioner has been ordered to be removed from the post of SEVIKA, working at Anganbadi Center No. 183 at village-Gamharia, Gram Panchayat Raj Naurangiya, East Champaran, without even noticing or giving any opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

And, for restoration of the petitioner on the post of Sevika at the Anganbadi Center No. 183 at village-Gamharia, Gram Panchayat Raj Naurangiya, East Champaran with all consequential reliefs.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, including that of filing a suit before the Ld. Civil Court having competent jurisdiction, for redressal of the aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.



3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
