ORAL ORDER

2 21-08-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Parbatta P.S. Case No. 255 of 2023 instituted for the offence
under Sections 341, 323, 325, 379, 385, 386, 387, 356 & 34 of
the Indian Penal Code.

3. Prosecution case in short is that while the
informant was going back after withdrawing money, he was
accosted with four miscreants, who on the point of pistol
snatched Rs. 5,000/- and fled away. It is also alleged that
accused persons have assaulted the informant.

4. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner
that the petitioner is in custody since 05-01-2024. Petitioner



bears two criminal antecedents, as per disclosure made in paragraph No. 3 of the bail application.

5. It has been further submitted by the petitioner's counsel that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. Petitioner is not named in the FIR. Name of the petitioner has transpired on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused, namely, Vishwakarma Kumar, and the same has no evidentiary value. Nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. It is submitted that petitioner was not put on T.I. Parade. It is lastly submitted that charge sheet has already been submitted in this case. Other co-accused has been granted bail by this Court *vide* order dated 14-08-2024, passed in Cr. Misc. No. 55295 of 2024.

6. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, period of custody of the petitioner, claim based on parity and charge sheet being submitted, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

8. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of
