ORAL ORDER

2 06-03-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following reliefs:-

“1. For a writ of Mandamus commanding the respondents to initiate the process of selection to the post of Anganwari in Balia Bujurg Panchayat, Ward No. 7, Block-Akbarpur, Nawada-District, pursuant to Advertisement No.1/2018 which was abruptly stopped due to objection raised in carrying out the Mapping of the Panchayat and had been resolved by holding that the majority of the inhabitants are



Extremely Backward Class.

II. For a direction that persons who have applied against the said advertisement is to be only considered for appointment as the vacancy related to 2018 and many on account of delay in selection may become over-aged."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, for redressal of the aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
