learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks regular bail in the present  
case registered for the offence under Section 414 of the Indian  
Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, petitioner is accused  
of stealing a motorcycle.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that  
petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence.  
Petitioner is in custody since 07.05.2024. It has further been  
submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the  
petitioner has clean antecedent.

5. Learned A.P.P. has vehemently opposed the  
prayer for bail.



6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, this application for regular bail is allowed.

7. Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned J.M.F.C., Jamui/concerned Court below in connection with Lachhuar P.S. Case No. 69 of 2024 subject to condition that:-

*(i). The petitioner will mark his attendance at the Sikandra Police Station, Jamui on the first and third Sunday of each month. Any default in appearance at the Police Station would result in cancellation of bail bond of the petitioner.*

*(ii). Before accepting the bail-bond of the petitioner, the court below will verify the antecedent of the petitioner. If the petitioner is found having clean antecedent, the bail-bond of the petitioner shall be accepted. If the petitioner is found having criminal antecedent(s), his bail-bond shall not be accepted by the court below.*
