ORAL ORDER

2 19-02-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1. That the petitioner prays for issuance of an appropriate writ / writs, order / orders, direction / directions to the respondents for quashing the order which contained in memo no. 530 (12) dated 03.04.2023 by which the representation of the petitioner has been rejected. However, by impugned order without considering the contention raised by the petitioner the same has been rejected which is violation of principle of



Natural Justice.

The petitioner further prays for direction to the respondents for reinstatement of the petitioner with all consequential benefits.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the Respondent authorities for redressal of his subsisting grievances, if any. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
