ORAL ORDER

2 13-02-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1. That this writ application is for issuance of writ of certiorari or any other appropriate writ or order or direction to the respondents especially the respondent no. 4 to select the petitioner as Anganbari Sevika of Kendra no. 131 of Ward no. 6 of the Bakhari Gram Panchayat in place of the respondent no. 6 who has been selected by the letter vide Memo no. 1 dated 28.7. 21 issued by the Mahila Supervisor (Respondent no. 5) contained in Annexure -4 cancelling the said letter contained in Annexure



-4.”

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
