ORAL ORDER

4 05-07-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

"1. That this writ application is being filed on behalf of the petitioner abovenamed for issuance of an appropriate writ/writs, order/orders or direction/directions in the matter of Mandamus, commanding and directing the respondents to not providing the appointment to her husband on account of death of petitioner's daughter namely Rita Kumari, Lady Constable No. 796 in Bihar Special



Arms Police-10, Patna on compassionate ground as there was matrimonial dispute between petitioner's daughter Rita Kumari (since deceased) and divorce petition has already been filed by petitioner's daughter on whose salary the petitioner and other four unmarried daughters were dependent and is entitled for the death-cum-retiral benefits of the deceased employee Rita Kumari (daughter of the petitioner)."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, for redressal of the aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
3. The writ petition stands disposed off.
