- 3 11-01-2024 1. The present petition has been filed for restoration of a writ petition bearing CWJC No.8719 of 2023, which has stood dismissed on account of non-compliance of the peremptory order dated 28.06.2023.
2. The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that



on account of inadvertence, the defects could not be removed, however, the same would be removed within a period of two weeks from today, hence a sympathetic view be taken and the aforesaid writ petition be restored to its original file.
