2 12-03-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

*“1. That this is an application for
issuance of appropriate writ / writs,
direction / directions to the
respondents to abstain from a
discriminatory practice of taking the*



service of the petitioner from the same panel till she attained 60 years age or till she duration of scheme with a rider that she has to qualify the eligibility exam through BELTRON and for setting aside the order dated 23.12.2019 vide memo no. 2341 issued by respondent no. 7 by which a decision has been taken to appoint the empaneled the Executive Assistant from the panel which has been made in various District of Bihar including Darbhanga District for only short terms of three month with a rider that they have to qualify the eligibility test taken by the BELTRON which is in contravention of the advertisement dated 02.07.2018 and/or any other writ/writs under fact or circumstances of the case.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the parties submit that the present case is squarely covered by a judgment rendered by a coordinate Bench of this Court dated 01.12.2021 passed in CWJC No. 7459 of 2020 (Rajveer Kumar vs. The State of Bihar) and other analogous cases, hence



the present writ petition can be disposed off in similar terms.

3. Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed off in light of the judgment passed by a coordinate Bench of this Court in the case of Rajveer Kumar (supra).
