ORAL ORDER

- 3 19-11-2024 Heard Mr. Satish Chandra, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Dilip Kumar No.1, learned APP for the State.
2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 447, 323, 354, 307, 379, 504 of the Indian Penal Code.
3. As per the FIR, the petitioners assaulted the informant by means of lathi and rod and also snatched golden chain from her.
4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. They have been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The allegation levelled against the petitioners is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. It is further submitted that the



injuries are simple in nature and there is an admitted land dispute between the parties. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) **each** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Ballia P.S. Case No.115 of 2024, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
