ORAL ORDER

2 19-08-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

"1. That the present Writ application is being filed in the nature of Mandamus for directions to the Circle Officer, Balia to decide the representation filed by the petitioner dated 10.07.2024, by which a request has been made to initiate Land Encroachment Case against all the encroachers with regard to the land situated in Sadipur Karari, Ward No. 03, Thana-Balia, Plot No. 378, which is a Gairmajarua Aam Land and to pass



necessary order in accordance with provision of the Bihar Land Encroachment Act, 1956.”

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the Circle Officer, Balia, District-Begusarai, for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
3. Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed off.
