APP for the State and learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
Opposite Party no. 2.

2. The petitioner apprehend his arrest in connection
with Udwantnagar P.S. Case No. 100 of 2024 for the offence
registered under Sections 341, 323, 498A and 34 of the Indian
Penal Code and Section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

3. Learned APP for the State at the outset submits that
the offences for which the instant FIR has been instituted
carries punishment of less than seven years. The said
submission of learned APP is not disputed by the learned
counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners and the informant.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits



that investigation in the case against the petitioner is still continuing but then the petitioners have not been given the benefit of Section 41(A) of the Cr.P.C., on which learned APP submits that anticipatory bail application be disposed of in terms of order dated 13.02.2024 in Cr. Misc. No. 3536 of 2024 (Naushad Ansari vs. The State of Bihar).

5. In view of the submission made by the learned Additional P.P., the anticipatory bail application is disposed of in terms of the order dated **13.02.2024 in Cr. Misc. No. 3536 of 2024 (Naushad Ansari vs. the State of Bihar).**

6. The petitioners would be at liberty to file representation before the concerned Superintendent of Police and the Investigating Officer of the case within a period of three weeks from today with a web copy of the order dated 13.02.2024 in Cr. Misc. No. 3536 of 2024 and the concerned Superintendent of Police shall ensure that the Investigating Officer of the case strictly adheres to the direction contained in the order dated 13.02.2024 in Cr. Misc. No. 3536 of 2024.
