ORAL ORDER

2 10-09-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P
for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Salimpur P.S. Case No. 58 of 2024 dated 01.03.2024 registered for the offences punishable u/ss 25(1-B)a, 26 and 35 of the Arms Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, one country made katta, three live cartridges, mobile phone and one motorcycle were recovered from the possession of the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. No incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. It is further submitted that the petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. As per the impugned order



dated 06.07.2024, the petitioner has four criminal antecedents. The petitioner is in custody since 02.03.2024..

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Barh, Patna in connection with Salimpur P.S. Case No. 58 of 2024, with the condition/s:-

(i) The petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable cause, the bail bond of the petitioner is liable to be cancelled.

7. The application stands allowed.
