ORAL ORDER

2 09-08-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in Pirabhore P.S. Case No.
650 of 2022, instituted for the offences punishable under
Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that, 95 liters
liquor was recovered from the house of co-accused Manoj
Yadav.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the
present case. Charge-sheet has been submitted in this case. No
incriminating material has been recovered from the conscious
possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has got no concern



with the alleged recovery of liquor. Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that the petitioner was not arrested at the place of occurrence. The alleged recovery has been made from the joint house where other family members also reside. The petitioner is in custody since 24.05.2024 and has got no criminal antecedent. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that similarly situated co-accused has been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 15.03.2024 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 20111 of 2024. There is no compliance of Section 100 of Cr.P.C.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Pirabhore P.S. Case No. 650 of 2022.
