2 19-08-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the
following relief:-

“1. That the present writ application is being filed on behalf of the petitioner for issuance of an appropriate writ(s)/ order(s)/ direction (s) to the respondents to set-up inquiry and furnish report to the respondent no. 4 in view of Memo No. 144 dated 06.04.2023, issued by the Incharge Officer, District Legal Section, Saran at Chapra, for



compliance the order dated 28.03.2023, passed by the respondent no. 4, based upon the complaint made by the petitioner relating to installation of Water Tower under the scheme of NAL JAL YOJNA, whereby the said respondent no. 4 has directed the respondent no. 8 to seek an explanation from the respondent no. 9, who has wrongly reported during the course of hearing relating to the subject land that it was registered in favour of the State of Bihar.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks a direction upon the District Magistrate, Saran at Chapra, to ensure compliance of his own order dated 25.4.2023 within a stipulated time frame, preferably within a period of four weeks from today, in accordance with law. It is directed accordingly.
3. The present writ petition stands disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
