ORAL ORDER

2 19-02-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following reliefs:-

"1. i) Issuance of a writ in the nature of writ of Mandamus directing the respondent authorities to fill up the remaining 28 posts of Bihar Home Guard Battalian, Rohtas which are still



vacant in Advertisement No.02/2011 and appoint the petitioners against the aforesaid posts.

ii) Issuance of a writ in the nature of writ of Mandamus directing the respondent No. i.e. Commandant Home Guard Battalion, Patna and District Commandant, Bihar Home Guard, Battalion, Rohtas to appoint the successful candidates i.e. petitioners against the remaining 28 vacant post with respect to advertisement No.02/2011 of Bihar Home Guard Battalion.

iii) Issuance of a writ in the nature of writ of Mandamus directing the respondents authorities to consider the representations made by petitioners for their appointment on the post of Home Guard Batttalian Rohtas, in which 28 post are still vacant according to the information received through R.T.I. regarding vacancy in Advertisement No. 02/2011 from District Commandant, Bihar Home Guard Battalion, Rohtas."

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioners to approach the respondent



authorities for redressal of their aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The present writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
