ORAL ORDER

The District Education Officer, Madhubani (respondent no.6) is directed to consider the case of the petitioner after affording opportunity of personal hearing and pass a reasoned and speaking order in accordance with law within eight weeks from the date of receipt of such representation.

3. It is made clear that respondent no.6 shall be solely liable for non-compliance of this order within the stipulated period.

4. With the aforesaid direction, this writ application stands disposed of.
