ORAL ORDER

2 27-08-2024 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well
as the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioner is seeking regular bail in connection
with Amarpur (Fullidumar) P.S. Case No. 217 of 2024 for the
offences punishable under Sections 25(1-b)a, 26/35 of the Arms
Act.

3. As per allegation, on a secret information, the
informant along with police personnel reached the place of
occurrence. The accused persons including the petitioner tried to
flee away after seeing the police party, but he was apprehended.
On search, a country made *katta* was recovered from possession
of co-accused Gaurav Kumar.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted
that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in
this case. He has further submitted that a mobile set and cash of



Rs. 2600/- were recovered from possession of the petitioner. No arms and ammunition was recovered from his possession rather one country-made pistol was recovered from possession of co-accused Gaurav Kumar. The petitioner is under custody since 13.03.2024.

5. On the other hand, the learned APP for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Considering the above-mentioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above-named be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand rupees) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Banka in connection with Amarpur (Fullidumar) P.S. Case No. 217 of 2024, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court.
