4 01-07-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned
A.P.P. and learned counsel for the opposite party no. 2.

2. The petitioner, husband of opposite party no. 2,
apprehends his arrest in a complaint case punishable for the
offence under Section 498(A) of the Indian Penal Code and
Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

3. Pursuant to order dated 27.02.2024, the matter was
referred to Mediation & Conciliation Centre of Patna High
Court to explore the possibility of settlement between the parties
and vide report dated 16.05.2024, the Mediator has reported that
the dispute between the parties has been resolved amicably



through the process of mediation and both parties are ready to live together, as husband & wife, and petitioner undertakes to keep opposite party no.2 with honour & dignity and both parties will withdraw cases within six months. These facts have been mentioned in Memorandum of Agreement dated 08.05.2024 attached with Mediator's report (flag 'M').

4. In view of aforesaid facts and circumstances, in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, let the petitioner, as named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of **Rs.10,000/-** (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M. (West), Muzaffarpur in connection with Complaint Case No. 489 of 2022, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure with further condition that *petitioner shall abide by all the terms & conditions, mentioned in Memorandum of Agreement dated 08.05.2024 before the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of Patna High Court, failing which, the learned Court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail-bond of the petitioner.*
