following relief(s):-

*“1(I) To quash the order contained in letter no.
229 dated 28.07.2023 issued by the respondent
no. 6 directing the petitioner to vacate the
premises allocated to him. (Annexure-9).*

*(II) To hold that the impugned order is
completely without jurisdiction.*

*(III) To hold that when the matter is sub-judice
before a court of competent civil jurisdiction, the
issuance of the impugned order is absolutely*
