2.      The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable u/s 341, 323, 324, 307, 379, 427, 34 354(B) of IPC.

3.      Allegedly, petitioners along with some unknown accused persons came with *farsa*, rod etc to capture the land of the informant. When husband of the informant and her family members objected, all accused persons assaulted them due to which they sustained injuries. It is also alleged that they took away Rs. 50,000/- cash, golden chain worth Rs. 90,000/-and other articles.

4.      It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that



petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. They have been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. Informant and petitioners are neighbour and from the perusal of ferdbeyan there is land dispute between them due to which petitioners have been made accused in this case. There is no specific allegation of assaulting the informant on petitioners. Injuries of the informant was found to be simple in nature. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

- 5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for bail.
- 6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, nature of injury, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Andhratharhi P.S. Case No.49 of 2024/ G.R. Case No. 395 of 2024 , subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
