2 09-09-2024 1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief(s):-

“1. That the present application is being filed by the petitioner for a direction(s) to the concerned respondent(s) to cancel the appointment of private respondent no. 8 and 9 namely Rakesh Kumar and Jainendra Kumar respectively because



the private respondents do not hold requisite qualification and their appointment has been made without following the due process of law as per the established norms.”
