“1. That this is an application for issuance of writ in the nature of writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ or writs, order or direction Commanding the respondents to pay the benefit of ACP (Assured Career Progression) and MACP (Modified Assured Career Progression) by way of time bound promotional benefit which has admittedly not been paid to the petitioner during the entire service tenure and till the date of retirement



from service for which the petitioner is legally entitled to.”
