2 13-11-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1. That the present writ application is being filed for issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus commanding the Respondents especially Respondents No. 3 & 4 to take immediate action to remove the illegal construction made



by the Respondents No. 6 to 8, by which they have encroached the way, which is 7 feet road/street and is passing through the front of the house of the petitioner.”

2. At the outset, the learned senior counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to pursue the liberty already granted to the petitioner, by this Court vide order dated 21.06.2023 passed in CWJC No. 18767 of 2015. Liberty so sought is granted.
