ORAL ORDER

7 30-07-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

"1. That this is an application praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction, commanding the respondent authority to consider the application of the petitioner describing illegal and forceful dispossession from his ancestral land even after registering an appropriate case against the Respondent no 4 and 5 wherein cognizance has been taken by the



learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Purnia and evacuate the illegal occupants from the ancestral land of the petitioner."

2. After some arguments, the petitioner, in person, seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, including that of filing a civil suit before the learned civil court of competent jurisdiction. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
3. The writ petition stands disposed off.
