2. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the
following relief(s):-

“1. That this is an application for issuance of an appropriate writ, writs, order, orders, direction, directions to the respondent authority specially Respondents No. -4 and 5 to take appropriate legal action against the respondent No. 7 for securing dignity and prestige of the student of the school and society.”
