ORAL ORDER

2 04-09-2024 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as
the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioner is seeking regular bail in connection
with Kumarbagh P.S. Case No. 29 of 2024 for the offences
punishable under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 414, 120(B) of
the Indian Penal Code.

3. The allegation against the petitioner is that the
petitioner was found indulged in sale and purchase of stolen
scoprio with co-accused.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted
that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in
this case. He has further submitted that nothing was recovered
from possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is under
custody since 09.05.2024.



5. On the other hand, the learned APP has opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Considering the above-mentioned facts and circumstances, the petitioner above-named is directed to furnish bail bond **after four months from today** and on doing so, the court below shall release the petitioner on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand rupees) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Bettiah, West Champaran in connection with Kumarbagh P.S. Case No. 29 of 2024, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court.
